During the attack on MT. ST.QUENTIN near PERONNE on 1st Sept., 1918, this N.C.O. acted as a Stretcher Bearer. His fearlessness and devotion to duty were of the very highest order. For 25 hours he worked without a rest over ground continually swept by shell and machine gun fire, dressing and carrying the wounded, and refused to rest until all his Company's casualties had been disposed of.

His initiative and knowledge of German proved invaluable in this action, for he organised squads of Prisoners, and helped them at work for hours stretcher bearing.

At HERLEVILLE on 19th August, this man was no less conspicuous. Here on one occasion, with admirable courage he went out alone amid a heavy bombardment, dressed a wounded man and carried him back to safety.
