At Gaza on the 26th March, 1917. This officer was in charge of the left flank of the Brigade of the Brigade during the advance through the prickly pear and trees to N.E. of Gaza: he kept in touch with the Brigade on the left. After advancing about 2 miles he was asked to assist in clearing out the Turks from a trench in the vicinity of 2 guns that had been seized, but could not be removed as long as the enemy held the trenches. Major Cameron led his Squadron in a bayonet charge against the trenches, 40 Turks were taken prisoners and 70 killed. This officer displayed gallantry throughout the action.
