Horses recuperating, men training, 2 1/2 hours per day for men with classes and lectures for officers and N.C.O.'s in afternoon.</p> <p>During the month 6 officers and 212 other ranks had leave at BIDI BISHR Change of Air Camp ALEXANDRIA. During the month Major CAMERON, BOLINGBROKE and CHATHAM and Captain NIMMO attended the Cavalry School for officers at ZEITOUN.</p>
