

HOD EL BATAR GE'EILA.	1/1/17		Regiment stationed at BATAR with one Squadron stationed detached at GAMAL and under O.C., 6th L. H. for operations.	
	2nd.		Regiment less two Squadrons moved to GE'EILA. Squadron at GAMAL remained here and put back under my command. One Squadron detached to GE'ISI.	
	3rd.		This Regiment took over from the 17th Camel company, posts at GE'EILA and GE'ISI.	
	6th		Post at GE'ISI reduced from Squadron to two troops.	
	7th		Patrol of 4 men proceeded to EL RISHA and brought in three Bedouins and 2x Camels.	
	11/12th		Party of two troops sent to EL RISHA to look for water, found to 22 feet but without success.	
	20th.		Regiment concentrated at GE'EILA. Posts at GAMAL and GE'ISI were not taken over by any other unit.
