Marakeb.

1st./18th.

Regiment with the rest of the Brigade at Tel el Marakeb. Training in Signalling, Hotchkiss guns, elementary musketry carried out. Course fired on range consisting of grouping at 100 yds., application at 200 yds., application at 200 yds. with Gas masks, application at 300 yds.

29/8/17.

Inspection of Regiment by Divisional Commander - Major General CHAYTOR.

13th.

Inspection of Regiment by Desert Mounted Corps Commander - Lieut. General CHAUVEL.

18th.

Regiment with remainder of Brigade moved from Marakeb to Kazar. The A. and N.Z. Mounted Division being now in support.

24th.

Inspection of Regiment by Brig. General RYRIE.

28th.

Inspection of Regiment by Commander in Chief - General ALLENBY.

29th.

Inspection of horses by Brig. General BUTLER.

26th.

Brigade tactical exercise. Lieut. Colonel L.C. Wilson in Command of Brigade. Operations in neighbourhood of GAMLI and ABREISA.

Since arrival at KAZAR, training in the form of physical exercises and musketry has been carried out.
