	1-10		Aboard H.M.T. "Madras" in Red Sea; Arrived at Colombo 10th inst. General Shore leave was granted to all troops aboard. Under arrangement, a special train conveyed a large party to Kandy, who thoroughly enjoyed themselves. The balance were entertained at the Y.M.C.A. where free Luncheon and Motor drives around the City were provided and both were largely availed of. All members of the Regt., returned to Ship at the appointed time. No. I43I Pte Newton F. (Ex Orari) was taken aboard here) <i>DCC</i>	
	12-24th.		Left Colombo for Fremantle, which was reached after on 24th inst. after an uneventful voyage. The time was passed chiefly in reading, games etc., also a number of Sports Programmes were carried through. Arrived at Fremantle, a Medical Inspection was made by the Health Authorities. No serious sickness was discovered, although about 50 men (including I4 from this Regt) were dis-embarked for quarantine reasons. No leave was granted here. <i>DCC</i>	
	25-31st.		Left Fremantle about 11am arriving at Port Sea early on morning of the 31st, Ship & Troops were again inspected and 11 men (including 7 from this Regt) were disembarked for quarantine reasons and were taken across to quarantine Station. The Ship moved up to Port Melbourne arriving there at 2 PM. Lt. Graham (Adjutant) & 6 O/Ranks dis-embarked for discharge. General leave was granted from 1600 to mid-night. All hands returned to Ship, excepting No. I43I Tpr Newton F & 3127 Tpr Wyatt W.H.L. <i>DCC</i>
