	4/3	0930	Dismounted Parade followed by general clean up of Camp. Casualties:-1 O/R Sick admitted.	
	5/3	0730	0900 & 0930. Divine service. Casualties:- 2 O/R sick admitted to hospital.	
	6/3 to 11/3		Training. The syllabus for week embraced work laid down in chapter VI. Y.&.M.R. Training. The work was of a quiet steady nature, as the sand here is very heavy for horses. Except Wednesday and Saturday the Regt. went out at 0930 daily and returned to Camp at 1500. Casualties for week:- 15 O/R Sick admitted to Hospital also Lieut. G.A. Smith sick admitted.

	13/3 to 18/3		Training. Regiment out all day excepting Wednesday & Saturday, on which days Camp was cleaned up in morning and troops went for a swim in afternoon.

	19/3	0715	0930 & 1010. Divine Services. Strength. 27 Off. 507 O/R. & 562 horses. Casualties:- 2 O/R Sick admitted to hospital.	
	20/3 to 25/3		Training. Regiment out all day except Wednesday & Saturday, which days were occupied by troops in cleaning up camp in morning and going for swim in afternoon.	
	26/3	0715	Casualties for week:- 4 O/R sick admitted to hospital. Lieut. Morrell transferred to Inf. Bde. & 6 O/R transferred to other units.	
	26/3	0715	0930 & 1010. Divine Services. Strength. 26 Off. 501 O/R & 527 horses. Casualties:- 1 O/R sick admitted to hospital.
