BAYUD	1/12/16	0500	<p>"Stand to". Carry out 0630 "C" Sqrn patrolled to SE. MASEIBRA about 6 miles and another patrol of "C" Sqrn. stationed @ MASEIBRA connected with patrol from Regt at BAYUD. This is a daily patrol from each station & was carried out throughout month, daily.</p> <p>Regt supplied 1 patrol to S. about 5 miles & 1 patrol to meet camel patrol NE, connecting about 5 miles from BAYUD. B Sqrn, 5th L. H. Regt, under Major Wright reported to Regt for duty and bronacked at GAMAL. 6th Regt supplied 2 day observation posts & 1 Sqrn supplied night outposts.</p> <p>made arrangements with "B" Sqrn 5th L. H. Regt stationed at GAMAL to patrol GAMAL to BAYUD. each alternate day 6th L. H. doing same patrol intermediate days</p> <p>Duties as above 11-bn C. B. Miller C.O. to ROMANI to report to C in C. Forces to visit Battlefield of ROMANI battle.</p> <p>Menual patrols & duties as above</p> <p>Regt conducted reconnaissance to G-EL-BARBA & EL-RAKWA, in conjunction with 2 Secs 14th I.C.C. & 1 Sec 5th I.C.C. The 3 sec. camels proceeded to ZAGADAN on 6th bronacking there the night of 6/7th. R.H.Q + 2 Troops "A" Sqrn & Lewis Gun left BAYUD 0400, arriving REUISAT 1600, established signal station there & proceeded to ZAGADAN, arriving there 0800 & established signal communication</p>

BAYUD.	7/12/16		<p>with REUISAT. The remaining 2 troops of 5th Sqdn left BAYUD 0600, arriving REUISAT 1800. At 0930 got into communication by helio., with camel sec. at point 1153 and at 1130 received message that the C-EL-BARQA patrol had returned to point 1153 & reported "all clear", this was transmitted to B.H.Q. Had no communication with EL RAWTA patrol & at 1330 instructed C.O. 14th Coy I.C.C. stationed at point 1153 to send patrol in the direction of EL-RAWTA, which order he carried out, but was unable to get in touch. At 1530 the RAWTA patrol returned & at 1600 the 6th Lt. H. Sqdn returned to BAYUD, arr. there at 1930. The day was very bad for signalling, being very cloudy. Mps to ZAGADAN the country is very fair travelling for horses, a good camel pad all the way.</p> <p>Duties as above. Major H. A. Bruin reported for duty from Superannuation, and being one officer over establishments, was not absorbed.</p> <p>1 Troop 2nd Lt. H. Bode M.C. Sqdn attached for duty & returns BAYUD.</p>

			captured 1 camel & 40 sheep/goats. At 1330, No 14 Sec I.C.C. returned to ZAGADAN
