HILL 70 1st to 22nd November 1916.	Musketry Training, etc.	
23rd November 1916	Moved from HILL 70 to Romani. Arrived Romani 1405 bivouaced for night.	
24th November 1916	Moved from Romani at 1000 to HOD EL KHIRBA. Arr HOD EL KHIRBA 1600 and bivouaced for night.	
25th November 1916	Regiment less 1 troop left HOD EL KHIRBA at 1030 and proceeded to HASSANYIA arriving there about noon, relieving Warwickshire Yeomanry.	
26/30th November 1916.	Outposts and patrols. Nothing to report.
