15/3/15. ALEXANDRIA 6 a.m.

The "Karoo" and "Anglo Egyptian"  
arrived & immediately disembarked.  
H.Q. M.G. B & C went in two trains,  
forage going next day and ammunition  
being handed into ordnance at  
Alexandria. Joined Mena Camp, Cairo  
during night.

16/3/15 MENA CAMP.

3 Officers from "Anglo Egyptian" joined.

18/3/15 ALEXANDRIA. 10 a.m.

The "Armada" with "A" Sq arrived and  
disembarked. A. Sqd. arrived at Mena Camp during  
night. Ammunition sent to Ordnance,  
Alexandria.

Only 2 horses were lost both through attack of pneumonia.

One case of measles was treated.

Health of men was good - Chief sickness resulted from vaccination and inoculation.
