4	acno	Officers Reconnaissance party of band & sketches rendered.	
5 + 6 + 7	acno	Routine Work & Drill.	
8 March	acno	Rgt moved out to take up position in front line & trenches with a frontage of about 6 miles	
9 - march to 14 April	acno	Constant Patrols were sent out, trenches dug & positions all along line strengthened.

26 to 29	ACMO	Routine duties
