15	<del>Acro</del>	Rgt assembled + moved out a part of, by ad to Salmana arriving 0830. bivouaced until 0700, water + fuel boxes +
17	Salmana <del>Acro</del>	Plains covered over Troops all day also Taube. One man killed by M.F. fire from Taube. 1800 Brigade moved out en route for Ma, an arrived
18	Majar <del>Acro</del>	0600 18th attack not checked home, troops returned at 1015. 1030 Brigade messaged + moved to Salmana, water + return journey.
