4/6/15	SYDNEY	8 A.M. arrived + disembarked horses + troops + marched to SHOW GROUNDS.	
12/6/15	ditto	2 nd Lieut. Fotheringham of C Squadron sent back to ADELAIDE for neglect of duties	W.S.
