25-7-15	SUEZ	8 A.M. Disembarked from "MEDIC" + left by train for Cairo. B Squadron under Major C. A. LEE embarked at BRISBANE on the BORDA on the 17 th June + landed at SUEZ	W.S.

31/7/15	CAIRO	7 AM. Inspected by Lieut-General SIR JOHN MAXWELL the C-in-C.	
2/8/15	CAIRO	9 AM. Sent guard of 9 officers, 20 sergeants & 122 rank & file to the ASR EL NIL barracks under MAJOR PARSONS for police duty in the city.	WS.
