19.2.16.	Helio polis	Inspected the site allotted to the 11 <sup>th</sup> Regt at 2 <sup>nd</sup> Oasis Camp Helio polis. Made all preliminary arrangements possible for the transfer.
20.2.16		Interviewed Col Cox 1 <sup>st</sup> L. H. Brigade re the return of all 11 <sup>th</sup> personnel from his Brigade.
21.2.16.		Advance party proceeded to 2 <sup>nd</sup> Oasis to lay out the Camp.
22.2.16	2 <sup>nd</sup> Oasis Camp	11 <sup>th</sup> Regt assembled with details as follows:- Headquarters and C <sup>o</sup> Sqdn from Racecourse 8 Off. 205 <sup>a/R</sup> A <sup>o</sup> Sqdn & details 6 " 369 " M. G. Section 1 " 10 " from Aerodrome Camp B <sup>o</sup> Squadron from Maadi. 5 " 121 " 20 " 705 " 1 M.O. attached 1 " Total 21 " 705 "

25-2-16	Helioopolis	<p>The Squadron from Maadi brought only 1 E.P. Tent and 4 Bells. Went to ISMAILIA and received instructions from General WHITE with reference to the reorganization of the Regiment. Also saw the A.D.O.S. with reference to Transport and Machine Guns.</p>
26-2-16	2 <sup>nd</sup> Oasis Camp	<p>Took delivery of two machine guns from 1<sup>st</sup> L.H. Brigade members at School of instruction Zietoun.</p>
29.2.16	2 <sup>nd</sup> Oasis Camp	<p>Daily State today shows  officers 25.  Sergts 44  of Ranks <u>725</u>  Total <u>794.</u> in Camp.</p>
