General BUTLER has command of the 53 Div. 1 Squadron of Egypt Cavalry & 150 of the BIKANIR Camel Corps are stationed here also. This Regt has been sinking wells 6M out at L. BEIDA. 17.1.16	LH WELLS L. BEIDA 3-15 PM.	Headquarters & M.G. moved from BIR HOOKER to the L.H. WELLS near LAKE BEIDA on 14/1/16. They were followed by B Squadron on 15/1/16 and A Squadron on 16/1/16. Reconnaissance is carried out daily to LAKE GARRA and the head of the WADI. A mounted patrol was reported 8 miles out in a NW direction from THE PAPS, touch could not be gained.
