1/1/15	MAADI 2 p.m.	Brigade marched past the High Commissioner for Australia, Sir George Reid, and was afterwards addressed by him.	
31/1/15	HELIOPOLIS 9 p.m.	Brigade shifted camp from MAADI to HELIOPOLIS so as to be near seat of the Divisions, viz. the New Zealand and Australian Divisions under the Command of Major-General Sir A. G. Godley C.M.G. etc.	
24/2/15	HELIOPOLIS 6 p.m. HELIOPOLIS 10 p.m.	Lieut. S.F. Rowell and 41 men (First Reg. contingent) reported for duty. Brigade + Divisional training carried out during past month.	Vide R.O. Part 2 24/1915
