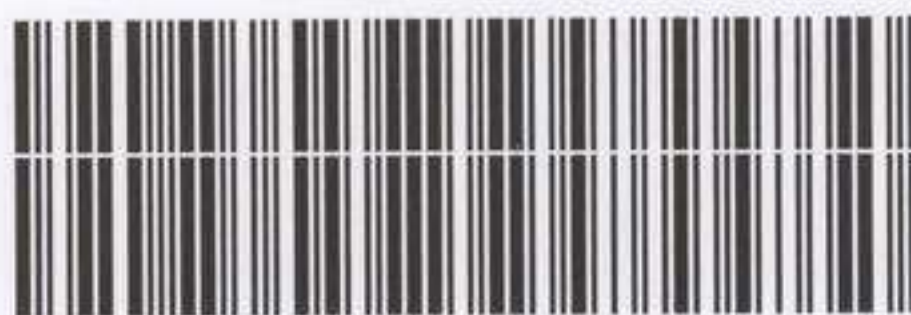

" " 3/4/17	Major Buxton returned from the Brigade Headquarters. Lieut. Bell marched in from No. 11 Company and assumed command of Australian Reserve Company.	
7/4/17.	110 camels marched in from Remounts.	
8/4/17.	Major Mason came down to Headquarters from the Brigade Headquarters.	
10/4/17.	110 camels and 58 reinforcements marched out to the Brigade.	
" " "	Major Mason returned to the Brigade Headquarters.	
11/4/17.	Colonel Huddleston came in to Headquarters from the 3rd Battalion.	
12/4/17.	Major N.B. de Lancy Forth marched out to the 3rd Battalion.	
18/4/17.	114 camels marched in from Remounts.	
23/4/17.	1 officer and 83 other ranks marched out as reinforcements to Brigade.	
24/4/17.	100 camels marched in from Remounts.	
25/4/17.	Captain H.R. Pettit came in to Headquarters via Hospital.	
26/4/17.	6 officers and 107 other ranks marched out as reinforcements to the Brigade.	
30/4/17.	24 camels & 6 reinforcements marched out to the 4th Battalion.
