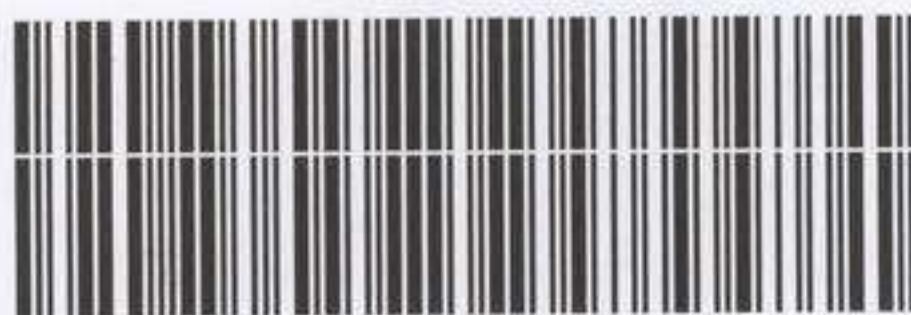

ABBASSIA. 1st.	13 enlisted Native Syces marched out to the 1st Battalion.	
4th.	4 officers and 63 other ranks marched out to the Brigade.	
9th.	Col. de Lancey Forth marched in from the 3rd Battalion.	
3rd.	70 camels marched in from Remounts.	
12th.	Major Buxton marched out to inspect No. 10 Company at Sollum.	
13th.	2 officers marched out to reinforce the 1st Battalion.	
16th.	334 Australian reinforcements marched in.	
"	30 reinforcements marched out to the 1st Battalion.	
17th.	Major Buxton returned from Sollum.	
"	1 officer and 28 other ranks marched out to the Brigade.	
18th.	The 334 Australian reinforcements marched out into isolation at Serum Camp.	
19th.	82 camels marched in from Remounts.	
23rd.	1 officer and 48 other ranks reinforcements marched out to Brigade.	
24th.	12 other ranks and 33 camels marched out to reinforce 2nd Battn.	
25th.	80 camels marched out to the 1st Battalion.	
26th.	19 other ranks marched out to reinforce the 1st Battalion.	
"	2 officers and 59 other ranks (N.E.) marched in.	
27th.	65 camels marched in from Remounts.	
28th.	6 officers and 75 other ranks (Aust. Field Ambulance) marched in.	
30th.	59 other ranks marched out to reinforce the Brigade. 15 other ranks marched out to reinforce No. 8 Company.
