

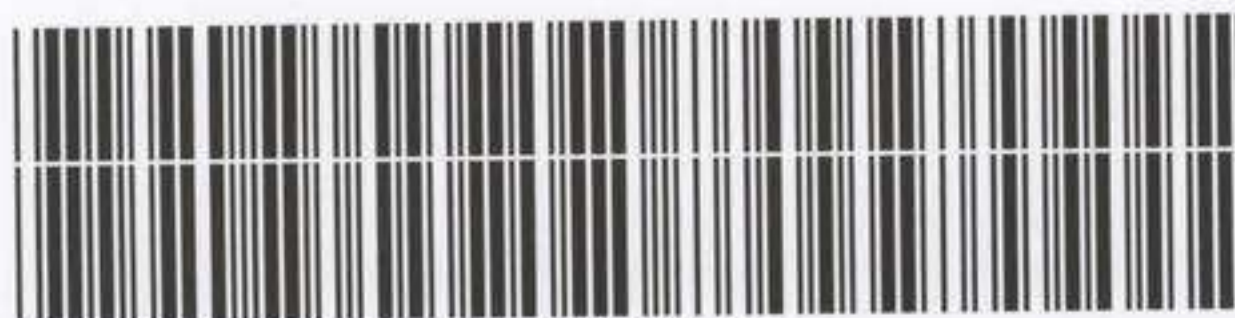

The relief was carried out without a casualty. The Bde was taken by train from YPRES to BRANDHOEK. Thence by march to Hutment Camp.	SA
