29/4/15	But fortunately it did little damage for our men by this time were well dug in. The enemy on several occasions threatened to make a bayonet charge - but our rifle & machine fire evidently prevented them from doing so. Our men behaved themselves splendidly.	10 + 13.21
19 5 15	After several quiet days - on the evening of 18 th May I rec ^d a message from the Brigadier to the effect that a division of the enemy's troops had landed on Square 278 M. I at once issued orders for everyone to be particularly watchful during the night.

	<p>and to stand to arms at 3 AM instead of 3.30 AM + it is fortunate that I did get up at 3 AM the enemy attacked in great force + came up in two solid lines right along our front only to be moved down by our rifle + machine gun fire. Three Japs actually tried to get over our trenches but were killed on the parapet. Considering the number who attacked us our losses were very light, our casualties only amounted to 10 killed + 20 wounded This attack lasted until about 6 AM.</p>	<p>10th 10th</p>

19/5/15 30 5 15		<p>Since attack on 19th May the enemy has been very quiet, hasn't made any fresh attacks, they continue to shell us every day but with very little effect.</p> <p>We are still occupying the third section of defence in the trenches the 9th Bn holding the section their right resting on Beach, then the 12th next out with the 11th Bn on our left.</p> <p>Smout Col OC 10 1915</p>
