

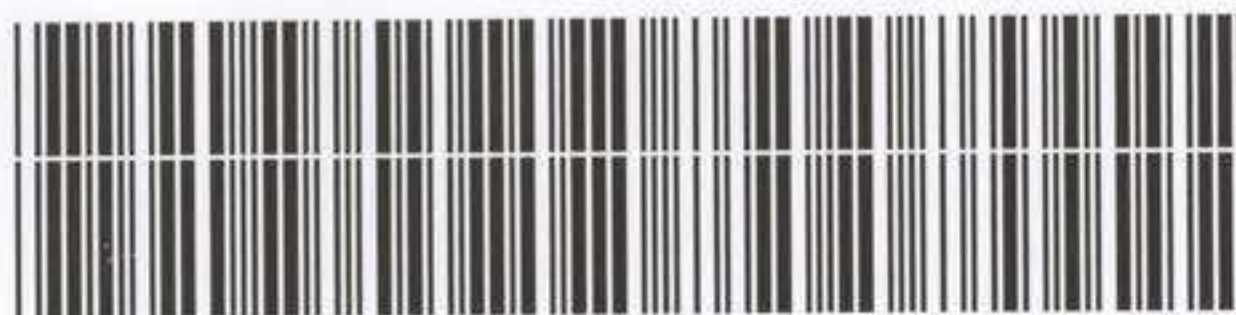

Cardonette	$\frac{2}{17}$	8.45 am	The Battalion moved from CARDONETTE to RIBEMONT leaving Cardonette at 8.30 am marched via ALNONVILLE QUERRIEN, LAHOUSOYE to RIBEMONT on the AMIENS - ALBERT Road arriving at about 8.30 pm.	
Ribemont	$\frac{7}{17}$	8.am	The Battalion moved to MAMETZ via BUIRE, BERNANCOURT, MEAULTE, to Mametz Camp.	
Mametz	7-23 Jan.		Battalion was engaged on fatigue helping to improve MAMETZ CAMP. Work consisted of Draining, Duckboarding Levelling, and erecting of cockhouses etc.	
"	24th. Jan.		Battalion moved from MAMETZ to TOWNSVILLE CAMP (Bernafay) as Reserve Battalion of 4th. Aust. Infantry Brigade.	
Townsville Camp.	25th. Jan.		Portion of Battalion engaged on small working parties around QUARRY SIDING. Remainder of Battalion engaged on improving TOWNSVILLE CAMP. The work consisted of Duckboarding, Levelling, Draining, erection of cockhouses and Latrines etc.
