

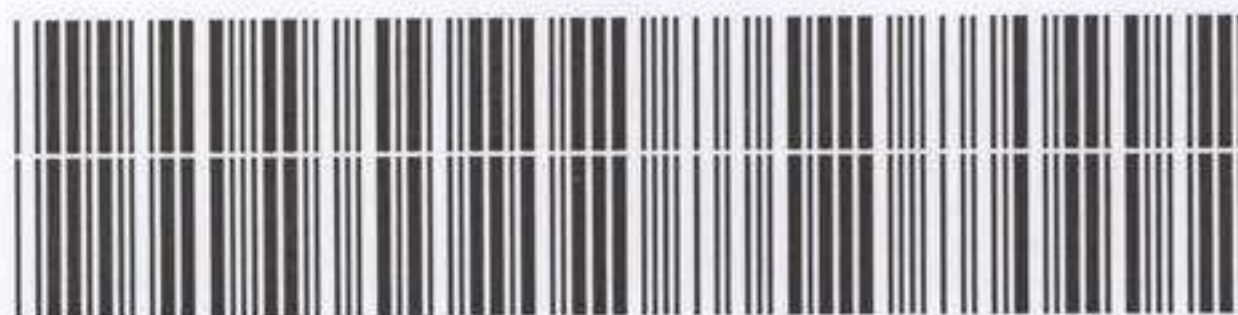

Ancient Abbey de Wdestine near St. Omer.	Week ending Aug. 4.		<p align="center"><u>26th Bn. A.I.F. Month ending Aug 31.17.</u></p> <p>Owing to the exceptionally wet weather and the difficulty in obtaining a suitable training ground, very little work could be done and this usually took the form of route marches. A visit of inspection was paid by Generals Birdwood & Smythe, who watched the different squads carrying on with the usual parade ground work. Lectures on various subjects were given to all ranks during the week.</p>	
	Week ending Aug. 11.		<p>The training this week consisted of smartening up & ceremonial drill, bayonet fighting, musketry etc. Route marches were undertaken every day including one all day march. The men are in very fine condition & no one fell out. Lectures have been given on various subjects, including the new German Shell Gas.</p>	
	Week ending Aug. 18.		<p>The programme of work this week is similar to last weeks & included wearing the Box-respirators for long periods at a stretch, the new gas used by the Germans necessitating this. Musketry practices were carried out on the 30 yards range & special attention has been paid to the training of reserves in all arms.</p>	
	From 18-31 Aug.		<p>Similar work was carried out as in previous weeks and in addition the Bn. practised wood fighting in the Forest of Blainmaris. The whole Division was inspected by Field Marshall Sir Douglas Haig on the 29th and he expressed great satisfaction with their appearance.</p>

Leave is given into St. Omer every day to about thirty men, and a few officers have had leave to Paris. Blighty leave has also been open for all ranks during the month. Several officers have returned from the Training Battalion, their places being taken by other officers from the Div.</p> <p>R.A. Wills 2/26. Sub. Officer 26th Bn.</p>
