Gallipoli	November 1915		The Battalion was relieved at Cheshire Ridge by the Canterbury Infantry Batt (N.Z.) and took up new position on Wellington Plateau. Mule Gully in support of 26 th Battalion who were loading Russell's Tobs.					
			From the 10 th to the 25 th good progress was made in digging underground shelter, but from then onwards much valuable time was lost, and the men put to great inconvenience on account of an order received on the 25 th to be in readiness for immediate embarkation.					
		15	Rained for two or three hours during the night.					
		27	Snow fell during the night with a low temperature, about 6° or frost. The casualties during the month were as follows—
