

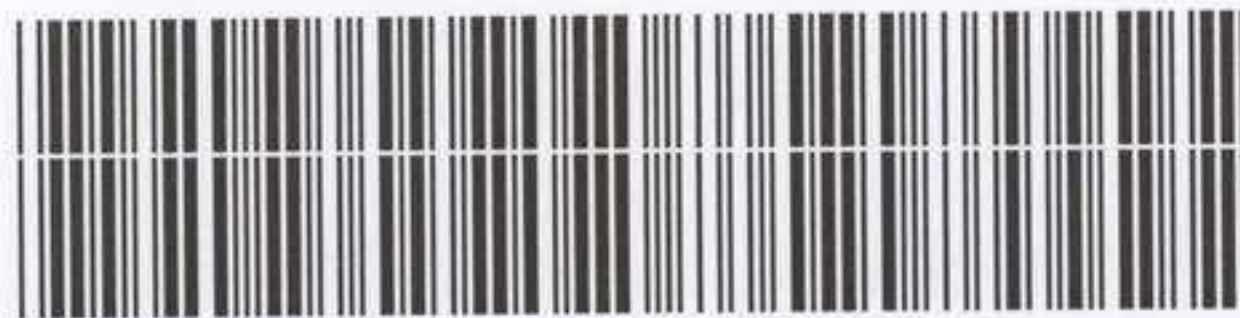

MUDROS (LEKINOS)	1916 January 6		The Battalion leave camp at 7.30 am & embark on the Troopship "Ausonia". In addition to the 28 th Batta. the 2 nd Divisional Train & about 700 details are on board. We remain in the harbour over night.							
ALEXANDRIA (Egypt)	"	7	Sailed for Alexandria about 7.30 am.							
TEL-EL-KEBIR	"	9	Arrive ALEXANDRIA about 2 pm after uneventful voyage.							
"	"	10	Disembark & at 10 am leave by train for TEL-EL-KEBIR. Need to reach early in the afternoon. The rest of the 2 nd Division A.D.S. 7 is already in camp.							
"	10	31	During this period, Company, Battalion Brigade training is successively carried on. On the 19 th January the strength of the Battalion is augmented by the arrival in camp of 281 men (Re-employment - 228 + 53 returned detail).
