

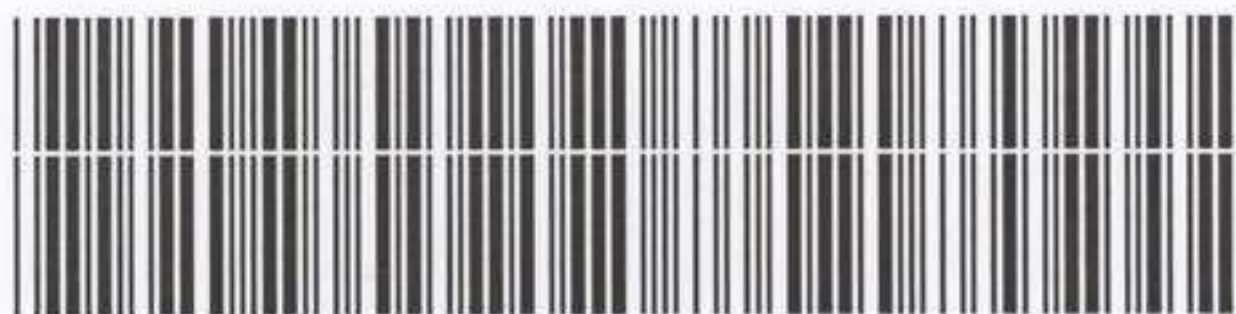

Date. 1916	Place and Time.	War Diary	Remarks or References to Appendices, &c., attached.
Feb. 3	Tel el-Kebir  FERRY POST.	The 7 <sup>th</sup> Brigade (including the 28 <sup>th</sup> Battalion) leaves Tel-el-Kebir today and proceeds <sup>via Ismaelia</sup> to Maguy Camp, about a mile to the east of the Suez Canal, which is crossed at Ferry Post. The Brigade acts as Divisional Reserve, the 5 <sup>th</sup> & 6 <sup>th</sup> Brigades <sup>forming</sup> a front line some miles further east.	
" 6	FERRY POST	The Battalion is detached as Garrison at Ferry Post on the <sup>eastern</sup> bank of the Canal. The Post comprises the old <del>old</del> line of entrenchments.

1916 Feb 6	FERRY POST	<p>to the immediate north &amp; south of the Ferry + also two detached posts - BENCH MARK + RIDGE POST - some two miles further north on the Canal bank. These latter posts are held by A Coy, the remainder of the Battalion being camped at FERRY POST.</p>	
29	<p>Collected @ edge of 7<sup>th</sup> Bde A.I.F.</p>	<p>Still at FERRY POST Casualties for February, 1916.</p>	
		<p>Dick to Hospital Deaths</p>	<p>1 Officer 73 Other ranks 2 Other ranks.</p>
