Neuve Eglise	Aug 1		Battalion at rest in Douve River Camp after coming from Messines Sector.	
"	Aug 3.		7 a.m. Battalion leaves Douve River Camp and marches via Neuve Eglise and Steenwerck to Vieux Berquin Area.	
Le Verrier	" 8		Battalion arrives at billets at 10.45 a.m. B'n. H.Q. at Le Verrier.	
Bailleul	" 15		9 a.m. Battalion commences march from Le Verrier to Hagerdrome Area (outside Bailleul). B'n. arrives at camp about 1 p.m.	
Bailleul	" 15		B'n. left Hagerdrome Area at 7 a.m. and marched via Bailleul to Bailleul Railway Station and entrained at 10 a.m. Went by train to Wizermes. Arrived Wizermes about 12 noon. Marched to Wismes via Lumbres. Arrived Wismes 6 p.m. B'n. billeted in Wismes Area. B'n. H.Q. at Wismes	
Wismes	" 15-31		Battalion trained at Wismes for the remainder of the month.
