Over the front media launch

The Australian War Memorial is launching a new permanent exhibition *Over the front: the Great War in the air*. The exhibition highlights the role of the young men of the Australian Flying Corps, and the risks, actions and drama of First World War aerial battles.

The Memorial's tradition of stunning multimedia displays will be continued using a dramatic audiovisual produced by acclaimed filmmaker Peter Jackson and Wingnut Films.

Over the front: the Great War in the air features five restored aircraft - three allied aircraft (SE5a fighter, Arvo 504K trainer, Airco DH9 bomber) and two rare German fighter planes (Albatros D.Va and Pfalz D.XII).
