ANZAC Day media website now available

The Australian War Memorial has now launched its special media website to help journalists prepare for ANZAC Day, when we honour all Australians who have served in conflict.

In 2009, ANZAC Day will allow for special commemoration of:

- ANZAC landing at Gallipoli, Turkey (25 April 1915)
- 10 year anniversary of the International Force for East Timor (INTERFET)

Journalists are encouraged to begin research early, by logging in to the password-protected media website for:

- Film and sound recommendations (allow 12 days for delivery)
- Image downloads
- Factual information, including Gallipoli statistics
- Story ideas, with themes of Love and War, Animals at War and First World War Aircraft ... and more

Interviews with Australian War Memorial historians are also available, including phone interviews from Gallipoli and Villers-Bretonneux on Anzac Day (limited times available, pre-arrangements only). Please email your request to media@awm.gov.au with an outline of your topic, so the appropriate expert can be identified.

Specific images from the Australian War Memorial's photographic collection will be available on request. Please email the accession numbers (maximum of 10 images) to media@awm.gov.au and allow 5 – 7 working days for images.
