I am the only Australian soldier in this camp. I have up to the present time received 10 parcels and also some private money. Would you kindly continue to send the money, as I find it almost impossible to ~~say~~ live on without it. Could you send me a serviceable suit of clothes? and a hat suitable for the hot weather. I am in good health and am working for the Railway Company. During the summer of last year I met with an accident whilst doing work for the company - I am afraid that it has made two fingers useless
