

Corporal Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG [109 words]

Corporal Ben Roberts-Smith, at 2 metres or 6 feet 6% inches tall, was an imposing figure on the battlefield. He wore this uniform during the assault into the Afghan village of Tizak in 2010, for which he was awarded the Victoria Cross. Roberts-Smith's patrol was inserted by helicopter under heavy fire, and the rapid deployment forced him to leave his body armour behind on the aircraft.

Later, when his patrol was pinned down, Roberts-Smith exposed his position to draw the insurgents' fire as he moved toward the enemy compound. He stormed two machine-gun posts and was instrumental in inflicting a significant defeat upon a determined and wellentrenched enemy.






The below exhibitions and key items will unavailable to view from 21 August 2023 until the new galleries open in 2025:

BACKGROUND

On Friday 7th July, the Memorial installed a revised label endorsed by Council, on existing exhibits referencing Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG. The displays occur in the HoV mannequin showcase and the Lower Galleries next to the painting *Pistol Grip*.

This label added additional context regarding the Defamation Trial raised by Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG. A label was not located next to the VC medals because of the proximity to the mannequin showcase and because of a lack of installation space. **Attachment A, B.**

During the week of 10th July, Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG appealed the outcome of the defamation case.

REPORT

On 21 August 2023, as part of the Development works, three galleries currently located in the Post 45 area will be closed for removal and conservation of some 300 objects for inclusion in the new galleries. Alternate displays have been approved by CMG for the revised footprint of the Peacekeeping and Middle East Conflicts galleries, the latter of which includes two paintings of Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG, including *Pistol Grip*. From this date audiences will no longer have access to these paintings. Therefore a revised label is not required for this location.





As noted above, labelling in the HoV is recommended for the mannequin showcase display only, due to proximity of the medal showcase and because of a lack of installation space.


"The Memorial assists in remembering, interpreting and understanding Australia's experience of war and its enduring impact. This includes the causes, conduct and consequences of war.

The Memorial acknowledges the gravity of the decision in the Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG defamation case and its broader impact on all involved in the Australian community. This is the outcome of a civil legal case, and one step in a longer process.

Collection items relating to Ben Roberts-Smith VC MG, including his uniform, equipment, medals and associated art works, are on display in the Memorial's galleries.

We are considering carefully the additional content and context to be included in these displays. The Memorial acknowledges Afghanistan veterans and their families who may be affected at this time."

- There are three (3) installations Recommend that labels only appear for the painting and the uniform. (See notes on VC below)
 - Paintings Recommend a similar size label be placed below the existing



• Uniform – Placed below existing label, similar label finish so that it is sympathetic to the installation. Will allow for changeovers of messaging if required.



- VC Medals Recommend no additional signage.
- A label for the VC medals cannot be integrated well into the installation, which is in proximity of the additional caption placed next to the uniform in the HoV.



Statement from Australian War Memorial Chair, The Hon Kim Beazley AC, on behalf of the Australian War Memorial Council

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Corporal Ben Roberts-Smith vc MG

Corporal Ben Roberts-Smith, at 2 metres or 6 feet 6½ inches tall, was an imposing figure on the battlefield. He wore this uniform during the assault into the Afghan village of Tizak in 2010, for which he was awarded the Victoria Cross. Roberts-Smith's patrol was inserted by helicopter under heavy fire, and the rapid deployment forced him to leave his body armour behind on the aircraft.

Later, when his patrol was pinned down, Roberts-Smith exposed his position to draw the insurgents' fire as he moved toward the enemy compound. He stormed two machine-gun posts and was instrumental in inflicting a significant defeat upon a determined and well entrenched enemy.

With six deployments to Afghanistan, Roberts-Smith is Australia's most highly decorated combat soldier from the conflict.

Accounts of alleged misconduct by a small number of Australian Special Forces soldiers in Afghanistan began appearing in the media from late 2016.

Claims were later heard in a civil defamation case unsuccessfully brought by Roberts-Smith against news agencies and journalists. In June 2023 a Federal Court Judge determined on the balance of probabilities that there was "substantial truth" to the allegations that Roberts-Smith was involved and complicit in unlawful killings in Afghanistan.
