# HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN POPPY

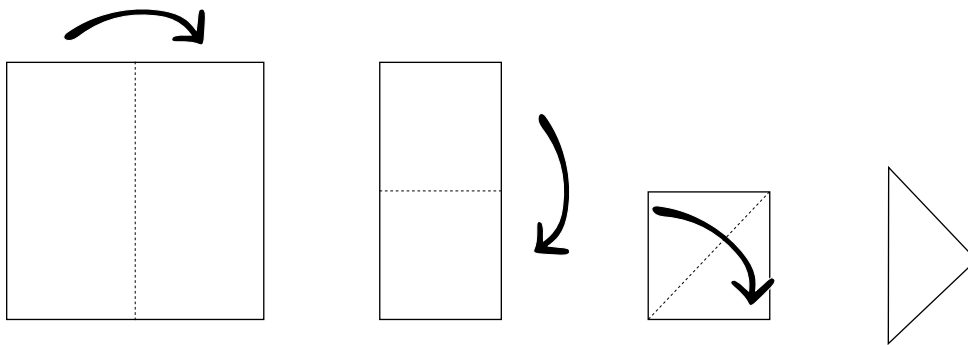
### HERE'S WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- A piece of red A4 paper
- A green chenille stem or pipe cleaner
- Scissors
- Glue
- Pencil
- Ruler

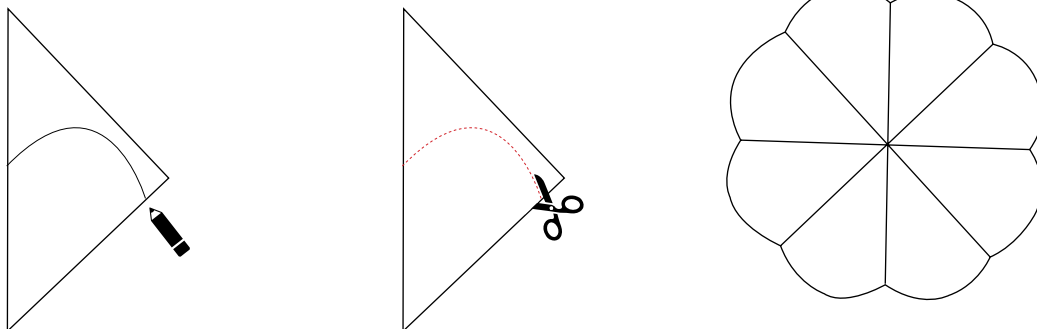
### ASSEMBLING YOUR POPPY IN FIVE STEPS

**STEP 1:** Measure and cut two 10x10cm squares from the red paper.

**STEP 2:** Fold a square into quarters, then fold once again on the diagonal. You should be left with one edge that's open.



**STEP 3:** Now mark out a curve across the open edge of the triangle, one that leaves you with even sides and a rounded top. Cut along the curve and open it out to reveal a flower shape.



**CONTINUED:**

**STEP 4:** Repeat steps 2 & 3 with your second piece of red paper.

**STEP 5:** Snip a hole at the centre of each red flower shape, thread the chenille through and twist to hold in place, adding a dab of glue on the underside for extra stability.
