COVID-19 Risk Assessment and Management Plan

For Terms 1 and 2 2021, school visitors to the Memorial are welcome, however can expect a different experience to that had in pre COVID-19 visits. Program types and capacity have been limited to ensure the safety of all visitors and staff onsite.

Category	Controls implemented
The environment	 Our reopening plan has been developed in line with ACT Government's <i>COVID-19 Easing of Restrictions Roadmap</i> (version 4.0) School groups will be met and escorted by Education staff as they arrive. Staff will request assurance from teachers that no teacher or student is unwell. School groups will enter and exit the Memorial separately to the general public. Timed entry sessions will be facilitated for Primary School groups: Monday to Friday on the hour from 9 am to 3 pm, Saturday and Sunday on the hour only from 12 noon to 2 pm Timed entry sessions will be facilitated for Secondary School groups: Monday to Friday at 11 am and 1 pm Student numbers at entry are limited to 90 students per session to allow for the required social distancing Maximum time spent in the gallery will be limited to 60 minutes A perspex sneeze screen has been installed on the reception desk in the schools' entry COVID-19 safe signage is prominently displayed Hand sanitiser will be readily available in the school's entry and program delivery area There will be managed transit of school groups through galleries Contact tracing details are available from school booking information if required There will be active social distancing management of visiting school groups by Education staff Designated toilet facilities adjacent to Aircraft Hall will be available for use by school groups A frequent cleaning regime of surfaces and spaces has been implemented

The program experience	 An engaging, curriculum linked program supported by exhibition collection and Education resources has been developed for Primary school visitors Exclusive use of Aircraft Hall for Primary School Education program delivery will occur The curriculum-linked program for Secondary school groups will take place in the main upstairs galleries Our group ratio has been reduced to approximately 1:10 for program delivery Our School Wreath Laying Ceremony program will be delivered in a modified form in the Memorial's Sculpture Garden The Last Post Ceremony attendance will have reduced availability during Terms 1 and 2 2021 with attendance limited to two participants only from schools entering at the 3 pm timeslot. Both Primary and Secondary schools will be offered a free online program; <i>Virtually there</i> alternative in lieu of an onsite visit. Details can be accessed from <u>school.booking@awm.gov.au</u>
Our staff	Memorial Education and Visitor Services staff have undertaken training regarding space management and visitor access
