Rupert Vance MOON	(Continued) Sitting down among his men with blood and sweat pouring from him he remarked "It was a hard fight boys, I've got three cracks and not one of them good enough for Eighty". Then he busied himself with the consolidation of the captured position and went down into the sunken road where he received a bullet through the face fracturing his jaw. Only then would he consent to retire from the fight. His bravery was magnificent and was largely instrumental in winning a fight against superior numbers, safeguarding the flank of the attack on BULLECOURT and gaining 184 prisoners and 4 Machine guns.
